**AIMS & OBJECTIVES :**

- 1) To cater to the educational needs of the children of the entire area of operation of the educational society by taking over the management of the affairs of the existing English Medium school under the name and style by providing necessary facilities and equipments for the sound and systematic education from the first standard to the matriculation level in both the medium of English and Telugu.
- 2) To establish similar schools in the entire area of operation for imparting primary, elementary secondary, higher-secondary and collegiate as well as the religious and moral education to the boys and girls with out distinction of caste, creed or color and to bring English Medium education within the easy and convenient reach of all classes of society and thus promote the physical, moral and also intellectual development of the children residing in the entire area of operation of this society.
- 3) To establish other schools with nursery, kindergarten, primary, elementary, upper primary, schools and also secondary, higher secondary and similar schools in the remotest villages for preparing pupils for the higher studies at such place or places as the general body and the governing body of this society deem fir and essential from time to time.
- 4) To establish and maintain educational institutions, professional and technologies etc., for promotion of literature, arts, science and technology, engineering, medicine, teachers training and various types of technical institutions so on as then decided by the board from time to time.
- 5) To device ways and means and provide facilities for the candidates to specialize in the above subjects by establishing and maintaining hostels, libraries and liaison with the officials and the non official bodies.
- 6) To seek affiliation from the state and central governments, university authorities and other official bodies to run the various courses pertaining to the various certificates, degrees and diplomas etc.,
- 7) To establish and maintain the residential schools or even separate hostels, boarding and lodging homes for the various types of appeals of the various institutions run by the society in different purpose of the district of Chittoor.
- 8) To run all educational institutions according to the Andhra Pradesh educational rules after obtaining the Government recognition and aid etc.,
- 9) To prepare students of the remotest villages for the 7<sup>th</sup> class and SSC public examinations and intermediate examinations where they have no previous schooling by running separate and exclusive classes in the evening besides conducting postal correspondence courses, if necessary.

- 17) To provide coaching facilities to develop the educational standards of backward students.
- 18) To implement the plantation and to establish good library facilities.
- 19) To provide scholarships to the deserved candidates by creating a special trust for the said purpose.
- 20) To develop cultural activities among the students by way of forming play grounds and purchase sports materials.
- 21) To establish computer and technical education centers for the development of the students.
- 22) To implement the programs of development of the villages and environment. To provide protected Drinking water for needy people.
- 23) To encourage students participation in Co-curricular activities
- 24) To appreciate a synthetic sense among students
- 25) To develop good citizenship qualities among the students.
- 26) To inculcate good habits and discipline among the students.
- 27) To strengthen coordination with other institutions and voluntary organizations.
- 28) To provide special coaching facilities to develop the educational standards of the backward and slow learners.
- 29) To organize entertainments for physical and mental development of the students.
- 30) To run technical educational institutions, vocational centers, adult education centers and schools and homes for the adult women according to the Andhra Pradesh educational rules after obtaining the Government recognition and aid etc.,



**4. THE RULES & REGULATIONS :**

The Rules & Regulations of the society are as regulations, detailed hereunder and for the present and if any change or changes are required it will be carried out, following the Rules & Regulations of the Societies Registration Act 1860 (Central Act No. XXI of 1860). A copy of modified Rules and regulations will also be sent to the concerned authorities for record in their respective offices and also a copy of the same will be published in the notice Board of the office of the society for ready reference to the members for information.

**5. AREA OF OPERATION :**

The area of operation shall be for the present Chittoor District of Chittoor in Andhra Pradesh and later it may be in entire India. **The charitable activities would be confined to the to the territory of INDIA only.**

**6. MEMBERSHIP :**

Any person above 21 years of age and who belongs to the Revenue District of Chittoor shall be eligible for the membership provided that he is recommended by two members of the society and it will have to be decided and admitted as a member of this society if they are willing to abide by the Rules & Regulations and also interested in the implementation of the Aims & Objects of the society. There is also no restriction regarding the total number of members. It is unlimited.

**7. ADMISSION :**

The person who desires to be a members of this society has approached the Governing body and pay Rs.10/- as admission fee to the treasurer.

**8. SUBSCRIPTION :**

Every Member of the society has to pay RS.100/- to the treasurer under subscriptions every year Any member failing to pay the subscriptions for a period of any month with in 3 months of the same being due to shall cease to be a members of the society. The board may in its discretion Re-admit such member after the payment of the arrears together with a Re-admission fee of Rs.10/-

**9. GENERAL FUNDS :**

The funds of the society consists exclusively of subscriptions from the members donations and other constructions and also the grants if any made by the Government and are applied solely for the furtherance of the objects of the society. **The funds of the society would be invested as per section 11(5) if the Income Tax Act 1961. The funds of the society shall have to be spent only for the attainment of the various objects of the society.**

**10. RESIGNATION :**

A member may resign his membership by a notice in writing address to the Secretary-Cum-Correspondent of the society provide however, that a resignation member shall be liable to pay the subscription due for the year in which the notice of resignation is received together with arrears of subscription etc., if any.

**11. RE-ADMISSION :**

Any person who has resigned or be removed of the member from the membership of the society may at any time be re-admitted at the discretion of the board on a fresh application being made therefore and on the payment of arrears, if an in full, members re-admitted shall be treated as new members for the purpose of rules of election of this society.

**12. REMOVAL OF MEMBERS :**

Any member who is in arrears of subscription shall be removed from the rolls list of membership we due notice by the secretary-cum-correspondent. He will however be re-admitted only on the payment of all the arrears due by him. Any member who is of unsound mind, and who is in the view of the Executive Committee Members conducts himself in a way which is prejudicial and detrimental to the interest of the society shall be liable to be removed by the directors from membership subscription will not be refunded.

**13. RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS :**

All the members shall be entitled to be elected to the Executive Committee Members of the society and to vote. Every member of the society shall have one vote only. Any membership of the society shall submit a resignation in writing to that effect to the Secretary-Cum-Correspondent which resignation will be considered by the board in their meeting as soon as possible and on its acceptance by the board, the members will cease to be a member of the society from the date of the meeting.

**14. MANAGEMENT OF THE AFFAIRS OF THE SOCIETY :**

The Executive Committee consists of Five (5) office bearers and four (4) Executive Committee Members as follows :

1) President 2) Vice-President 3) Secretary Cum Correspondent 4) Joint Secretary 5) Treasurer 6) 4 E.C.Members. The total strength of the committee members shall be **Nine**. They shall be elected by the General body at its annual meetings when due according to the Rules & Regulations of this society. The members of the board shall hold office ordinarily for a period of one year or until their successors are elected. But the first members of the governing body as noted in the Memorandum of Association will have to remain in office for a period of 5 years commencing from the date of following registration of this society by the District Registrar of Assurances, Chittoor under provisions of Societies Registration Act 1860 Central Act No. XXI of 1860, to over come the teething troubles in Society. Thereafter the next body will have to remain in office only for a period of one year only. There is no bar to the managing committee to be on the board if elected unanimously.

**15. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF OFFICE BEARERS :**  
**PRESIDENT :**

- A) The President shall preside over the Executive Committee Members Meetings, Annual General Body Meetings and extra-ordinary general body meetings of the society and shall exercise over all control over the affairs of the society.
- B) In case of the votes for and against on a particular issue are equal the president shall exercise his casting vote.
- C) The President shall be entitled to invite any person to attend meetings of the society but such persons shall have no power of voting.

**VICE-PRESIDENT :**

The Vice-President will preside over the Executive Committee Members or General Body Meetings in the absence of the president.

**SECRETARY-CUM-CORRESPONDENT :**

- A) In the absence of any specific directions of the Governing Body the Secretary-Cum-Correspondent shall call for the meetings of the society and the General Body as well. He prepare the budget estimates for the coming year and after obtaining the approval of the governing body place for sanction at the general body.
- B) He has power to appoint, punish, suspend or dismiss servants employed in the conduct of the affairs of the society subject to the control of the governing body for the management of all the affairs of the society. To oversee the affairs of the institution run by the society. To be responsible for the maintenance of discipline and smooth running of the society.
- C) To open bank account with any Nationalized bank with the permission of Secretary-Cum-Correspondent. **The Secretary-Cum-correspondent shall operate the bank account jointly with the treasurer.**

**TREASURER :**

In the absence of the specific directors of the Governing Body otherwise, the treasurer shall collect subscriptions, donations, rents and such other money as may be due to the society and deposit the same in the society name. **She shall operate the bank accounts along with the Secretary-Cum-Correspondent.**

**POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS :**

Subject to the provisions of the Memorandum of society, the Executive Committee Members shall have the following powers. To control, manage and supervise the administration of all educational institutions besides hostels, orphanages and care-homes established and run by the society affairs of the society.

- A) To sanction the budget estimates and expenditure for the year.
- B) To examine and approve the annual accounts and balance sheet of the society and exercise full authority over the management of the funds of the society.
- C) To co-operate and collaborate with other institutions in the matter of education, cultural, training and other programs.

- D) To create, administrative research, technical ministerial posts, prescribe service rules.
- E) To enter into agreements, on behalf of the society and defend all legal proceedings on behalf of the society.
- F) To invite any person or persons, not belonging to members of the board to meetings. But such invite person shall not be entitled to vote at the meetings.
- G) To make enforce, adopt, amend or prescribe from time to time rules and Bye-laws for the regulation and any purpose shall not be entitled to vote at the meetings.
- H) To make enforce, adopt, amend or prescribe from time to time rules and Bye-laws for the regulation and any purpose connected with the management of the affairs of the society.

**16. DELEGATION OF POWERS :**

The Executive Committee Member by resolution can delegate powers to the President or secretary-cum-correspondent or any other officer such of its power for the conduct of business as it may deem fit.

- 17. The annual General Body Meeting shall be held on 1<sup>st</sup> May of every year at which all the following matters shall be dealt with by the general body.
  - A) To elect the Executive Committee Member when due according to the Rules an Regulations.
  - B) To pass the budget estimates for the ensuing year of account and to approve the expenditure statement of the previous year.
  - C) To approve the annual report of the activities of the society.
- 18. Income and property of the society however derived shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects as set forth in the Memorandum of Association. No part of the income and property of the society shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of the members of the society provided that nothing here in shall prevent payment of reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or employee of the society in return for service rendered to the society.

**19. FUNDS OF THE SOCIETY :**

The funds of the society shall consist of the following.

- 1) Membership Fee
- 2) Donations and contributions.
- 3) Grants by the Central or State Government or other agencies.
- 4) Income on investments.
- 5) Income and receipts from other sources
- 6) The funds of the society shall have to be spent only for the attainment of the various objects of the society.
- 7) The society has to get Registration u/s 12A / Exemption u/s 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961-Opportunity u/s 12AA(1).

All funds shall be paid to the society account in any nationalized bank and shall not be withdrawn authorized under India society act and shall not be with drawn except by means of the cheque signed by the Secretary-Cum-Correspondent of the society as may be duly empowered on this behalf by the Executive Committee Member.

- a) Accounts of the society would be maintained and audited regularly by a Chartered Accountant (as per section 288(2) of the Income Tax Act) appointed by the board. The detailed managements with regard to the form of accounts their maintenance and presentation shall be decided with the auditors by the board.
- b) The financial year of the society shall be from April to March in the year.

**21. WINDING UP OF THE SOCIETY :**

In case of the society desires to wind up its activities then **the assets and the funds of the society will remain after the full satisfaction of the liabilities of the society will be transferred or paid to some other society and enjoying exemption U/s 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961.** Any funds or property whatever, the same shall not be paid or disturbed among the members of the society as may be decided by the general body.

**22. AMENDAMENT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS :**

No amendment or alteration are made for the purpose of this unless it is voted by 3/5<sup>th</sup> of the members present at a general body meeting convened for the purpose and confirmed by 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the members present at these and special meeting after one month as provided for under the societies registration Act, 1860. (Central Act No. XXI of 1860). Any amendment or alteration would be carried out only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, Tirupathi.
